STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The School, without penalty or obligation shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for all school charges, less the amount of \$100 non-refundable registration fee, if a written notice of cancellation is made prior to or on the first day of instruction. Cancellation or any refund request shall be made in writing to: Santiago Rodriguez, Director, America Truck Driving School, Inc. The cancellation letter can be mailed, faxed, or dropped off in person to the main office. The student has a right to a refund of charges less the amount of \$100.00 for the non-refundable registration fee if he/she cancels this agreement prior to or on the first day of instruction or after 7th day after enrollment, whichever is later.
